### PHOTO statement

My recurring theme has been Seasons in Sequence, which teaches of life's ephemerality. I have returned to the same site during different times of day and on different days, and do so for all four seasons. Every year, I would seek a new scene to shoot.

Focusing upon a single scene deepens my intimacy with nature. I would set up and then just wait for the birds to greet the dawn with song, or for the clouds to unveil the sun, or for the wind to settle and to steady the leaves, or for my thoughts to bud and blossom and reach fruition. For each scene, I would photograph more than a dozen photos, and from each series would select just one photo to represent each season.
